The Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 o'clock A.M. with Jean Heiden, chair presiding. Members present were Schultz, Heiden, Muhlbauer, and Rosburg. Member absent was Dozark.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board approved the hiring of Ivan Zamago – Seasonal Yellow Smoke Park Attendant and change of status – Connor Paulsen – Yellow Smoke Park Ranger, Conservation.

At 10:05 o'clock A.M., as advertised, motion was made by Schultz, seconded by Muhlbauer to open the Public Hearing regarding the vacation of the following roadway segments: All that part of 273<sup>rd</sup> Street lying north of Deloit Blvd in the West ½ of Section 24 T84N, R39W and all that part of an unnamed roadway lying east of Deloit Blvd in the SW ¼ Sec 5 T84N R38W for May 21, 2024 at 10:05 o'clock A.M. Motion was passed unanimously. There were no written objections or oral objections. At 10:06 o'clock A.M. a motion was made by Muhlbauer, seconded by Rosburg to close the hearing.

Motion was passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Rosburg, seconded by Schultz to approve the following resolution:

(Final Order Road Vacation)

WHEREAS, This being the date and time set for the hearing on the proposed vacation and closure of Crawford County Secondary Roads described as follows:

**Goodrich Township**

All that part Road No. 847(AKA 273<sup>rd</sup> St.) & Road No. 627 lying north of Deloit Blvd in the West ½ of Section 24 T84N, R39W. As shown on accompanying map.

**Milford Township**

All that part of unnamed roadway lying east of Deloit Blvd in the SW ¼ NE ¼ Section 5 T84N, R38W. As shown on accompanying map.

WHEREAS, no objections have been received, either in writing or by persons present.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Crawford County Board of Supervisors that the subject roads be ordered vacated and closed.

Voting Aye: Schultz, Heiden, Muhlbauer and Rosburg. Motion was passed unanimously.

Rachel Burns spoke to the Board about the current MEI call rates. A motion was made by Schultz, seconded by Muhlbauer to approve the MEI call rate to \$200 plus mileage.

Motion was passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Schultz, seconded by Rosburg to approve the Natural Gas Connection at the City Center 115 N 14<sup>th</sup> Street – eliminating 4 meters.

Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Muhlbauer, seconded by Rosburg to approve the tax abatement for 1913 260<sup>th</sup> St, Denison, Neil & Juli Boettger – new home.

Motion was passed unanimously.

At 10:33 o'clock A.M., a motion was made by Muhlbauer, seconded by Rosburg to open the Closed Session of the discussion of Hazardous Liquid Pipeline Ordinance and Potential Litigation per Iowa Code 21.5(1)(c). Motion was passed unanimously.

At 11:44 o'clock A.M., a motion was made by Muhlbauer, seconded by Rosburg to close the Closed Session. Motion was passed unanimously.

On motion duly seconded the Board adjourned at 11:45 o'clock A.M.
