The Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 o'clock A.M. with Jean Heiden, chair presiding. Members present were Schultz, Dozark, Heiden, Muhlbauer, and Rosburg.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

A motion was made by Schultz, seconded Rosburg to approve the following resolution:

Crawford County Resolution #2024-34  
Reclassifying certain Secondary Road from Area Service B Road to Area Service C Road.

WHEREAS, Crawford County desires to classify certain roads on the secondary road system in the county to provide for a minimal level of maintenance; and

WHEREAS, Crawford County, after consultation with the Crawford County Engineer, has the authority under Iowa Code Section 309.57 to designate certain roads within the County as Area Service "C" per Crawford County Ordinance #2004-3, and

WHEREAS, the Crawford County Board of Supervisors, after consulting with the Crawford County Engineer, desire to designate the following road to be classified as Area Service C, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Notice of Public Hearing duly published according to the Iowa Code, Public Hearing as held on October 22, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors room at the Crawford County Courthouse, Denison, Iowa, to hear support and/or objections from the public on road so designated.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CRAWFORD COUNTY that this County does hereby establish the roads described as Area Service "C" roads with restricted access and a minimal level of maintenance.
