Iowa State Representative, Steve Holt joined the Board via phone with some Legislative updates.

A motion was made by Heiden, seconded by Schultz to approve the Agreement for IDOT initiated Detour of Primary Highways onto Local Roads – US 30 Detour, Clark Street (Dow City) to US 59.

Motion passed unanimously.

Amy Pieper presented the Crawford County Historic Preservation annual report to the Board.

A motion was made by Rosburg, seconded by Dozark to approve the lawn spray bid from Phil's Lawn, Landscaping & Nursery.

A motion was made by Heiden, seconded by Dozark to approve the buffalo grass on bank of westside of jail bid from JP Turf and Pest.

A motion was made by Rosburg, seconded by Heiden to approve the pest control at the Courthouse bid from JP Turf and Pest.

Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Heiden, seconded by Dozark to approve the pest control at the CCCS Building bid from JP Turf and Pest.

Motion passed unanimously.

The Board had a discussion about the Bell Cabin, the cabin is dis-assembled at restoration and will return to Dow House. No action was taken at this time.

A motion was made Heiden, seconded by Rosburg to approve the resignation of the IT Director as of February 14, 2025, and payout of vacation.

Motion passed unanimously.

The Board had a discussion about an IT Contractor. Colin Johnson, County Attorney, stated Crawford has an 28E agreement with Carroll County. No action was taken at this time.

During citizen input Rachel Burns addressed her concerns about EMS at the hospital, Comm Center, and lack of emergency volunteers.

On motion duly seconded the Board adjourned at 11:22 o'clock A.M.
