The Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 o'clock A.M. with Dave Muhlbauer, chair presiding. Members present were Schultz, Dozark, Muhlbauer, and Heiden. Member absent was Rosburg.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Iowa State Representative, Steve Holt joined the Board via phone with some Legislative updates.

The Board approved the change of wage for Damon Crampton, Construction Employee II, and Troy Rosburg, Maintenance Employee I, Engineer's Office.

The Board approved the resignation of Lynn Nulle, Finance Manager, Public Health.
